WHAT WE OFFER

Kindercamp

This is a preschool camp for children ages 3-5. We provide a developmentally appropriate learning environment implemented through themed centers that is enriched with swimming, sports, and movements. Begins June 20th and will run in 1 weeks sessions ending on August 24th. Hours are 9am-1pm on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

Y-Camp

A camp for school aged children who have completed Kindergarten through 4th grade. Our action-packed, full-day camp reveals a fascinating world of field trips, swimming, story telling, nature study, singing, arts and craft, sports, games, and so much more! We incorporate our core values into all YMCA programs and activities.

Explorer Camp

This camp is specifically designed for pre-teens and teens, up to age 15. Campers will enjoy field trips, team-building, sports, character development, and the list goes on! Groups are divided further by age and gender, as necessary.
